Fort Calhoun CommUnity Garden Preparation Weekend

With the weather finally turning toward Spring, we have set aside a couple of times in May to prepare for the planting of the garden. Saturday morning on May 19 we are looking to begin to get the garden ready, and work on holding those pesky weeds at bay. Sunday afternoon on May 20 finishing up the prep work.

Here are some of the items we need to get done on this weekend:

- Fix the raised beds the weather takes a toll on them.
- Turn over the raised beds
- Till up the planting rows
- Lay weed barrier between the planting rows
- Set up green bean poles and netting
- Set up poles for cucumbers, and other plants to help keep them off the ground
- Clean out the water tanks and position them for the season
- Check tomato cages and fix broken ones
- Create a list of needed tools or equipment to help the garden be prosperous

Remember that this garden is truly a community garden. If you don't plant a garden anymore, come and help and then share in the fresh produce. We give it all away. What a great opportunity to help children learn how to garden and to share.

Many hands make for light work and for getting things all ready for the growing season!
